Bibs at registration/check-in. Alpha by last name. Shirts handed out at T-shirt tent; you can get before or after race

5K Food: Section 4. Post-race, runners receive Panera bagel/Fresh Point fruit.

SURVIVORS: Section 3. Check-in at Survivors tent for survivor shirt, bandanna/skull cap, photo booth 'fast pass', and key info for the survivor ceremony. For 5K survivors, you'll still need to go to Registration in Section 1 to get your race bib.

ONLINE SILENT AUCTION: Section 2. Closes at 10:45am. Winners pick up items after walk.

TEAM PHOTOS: Section 4. Your team can meet at the tent in Section 4 (other side of stage)

FOOD/DRINKS: Section 4. Have cash and credit card on hand.
